1. The journal adopts a double-blind refereeing procedure.
2. The Editor makes a preliminary judgment whether or not to process the submission.
3. Submissions that do qualify for further processing will be sent to two referees for review. Their review will determine whether the submission is (a) unpublishable, or (b) publishable without revision, or (c) publishable with revision. The entire process takes about five weeks.
4. If the submission requires revision, the revised version must integrate/incorporate the necessary changes and editorial suggestions in a satisfactory manner for it to be acceptable for publication. The author and the Editor can agree on a revision schedule.
5. Formal acceptance will be communicated to the author together with the estimated time of the publication. Proofs in PDF will be sent in due time thereafter.
6. Upon publication, authors will receive a digital copy of their article in PDF.
